Bayard Rustin

I was an activist who fought for the rights of black people in America!

I was friends with Martin Luther King Jr, and I organised the 1963 March on Washington where he delivered his "I Have A Dream" speech

I was open about being gay at a time when that was dangerous - so I had to **be brave** to be myself





I am a musician, an actor, and a human rights campaigner

I believe that everyone is unique and special, and that you are **perfect just the way you are** - you were born this way!


I have used my fame to fight for equality for lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender people

I am an actor and campaigner for equality and human rights!

I was the first transgender woman to appear on the cover of TIME magazine and I had a wax figure made of me in Madame Tussauds I believe that **beauty is about what is in your heart and soul**, not about how you look



Katharina Lindner

I was a footballer who played as a striker for Glasgow City Football Club!

I won lots of titles and cups in my football career, and I have been described as "**one of the finest players ever** to have played in Scotland"

I was also a lecturer at Stirling University, and my partner Laura founded Glasgow City Football Club





I am a retired para swimmer and triathlete from Scotland!

I was born with part of my right arm missing, and I was bullied at school - but I did not let that stop me from **achieving my dreams**

I represented the UK at major sports competitions and events all across the world



Maureen Colquhoun

I was a former Member of Parliament (MP) in the House of Commons!

I was the first known lesbian MP and my wife was a magazine editor called Barbara

I wasn't treated very kindly by other people because of who I was, but I always **believed in a fairer world** and fought for women's rights



I am a Native American former soldier, and aircraft engineer!

Shahe

I was the first transgender man to serve openly in the American military

There was a ban against transgender people being soldiers in America, which I fought against with many other campaigners because **I wanted to be treated equally**


Time for Inclusive Education


Marie Maitland

I am considered one of the greatest tennis players of all time!

In the 1970s, a male tennis player told me that I could never beat him because I am a woman. He dared me to play a game with the world watching on tv - so I did, and I won
